John's daughter Ann marries Archie Cann – the first wedding photograph taken at Pengenna!
1925
The Blewett's buy Pengenna from the Molesworth family.

1939
John's son Roy Blewett takes over.

1963
Roy's daughter Jennifer marries and is photographed outside Pengenna with her father.

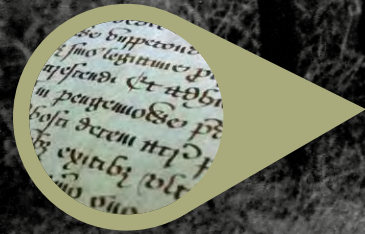
1976

Pengenna sold by the Prince of Wales to the Molesworth family of Pencarrow Estate.

The original medieval wing is partly demolished.

The Cowyard Barn

- Rustic bar serving a good range of local beers, wines and spirits.
- Entire side of barn can be opened.
- Outside seating with fire pit.
- Toilet block next door.
- Catering space with sink area.
- Fridges for chilling drinks and storing ice.
- 120 inch drop down screen for projecting photos/videos.

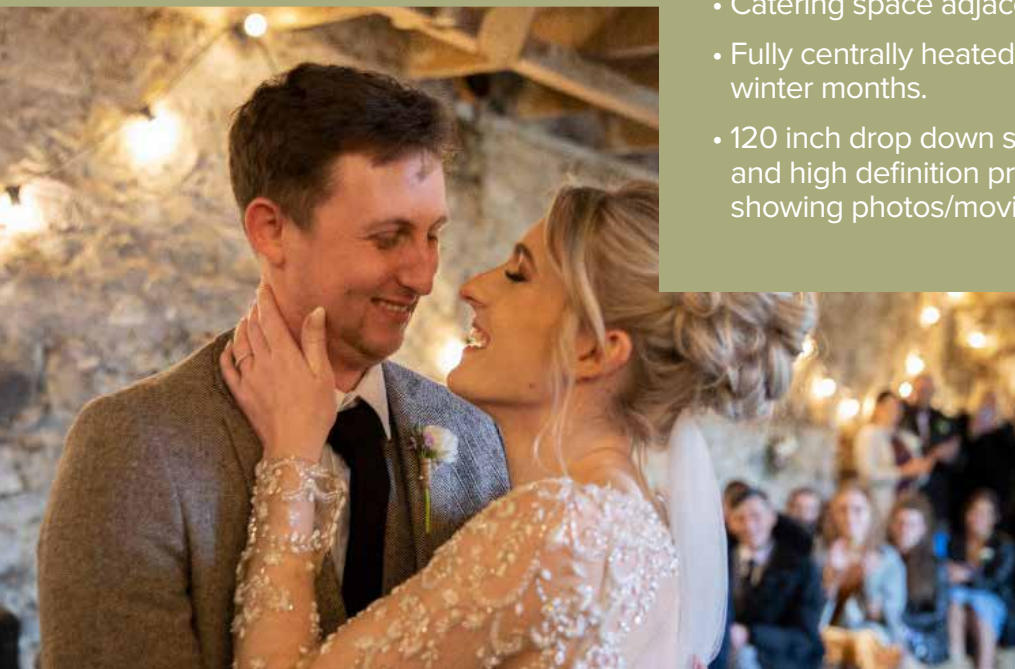






The Stables

- Stunning views out across the lawns and valley beyond.





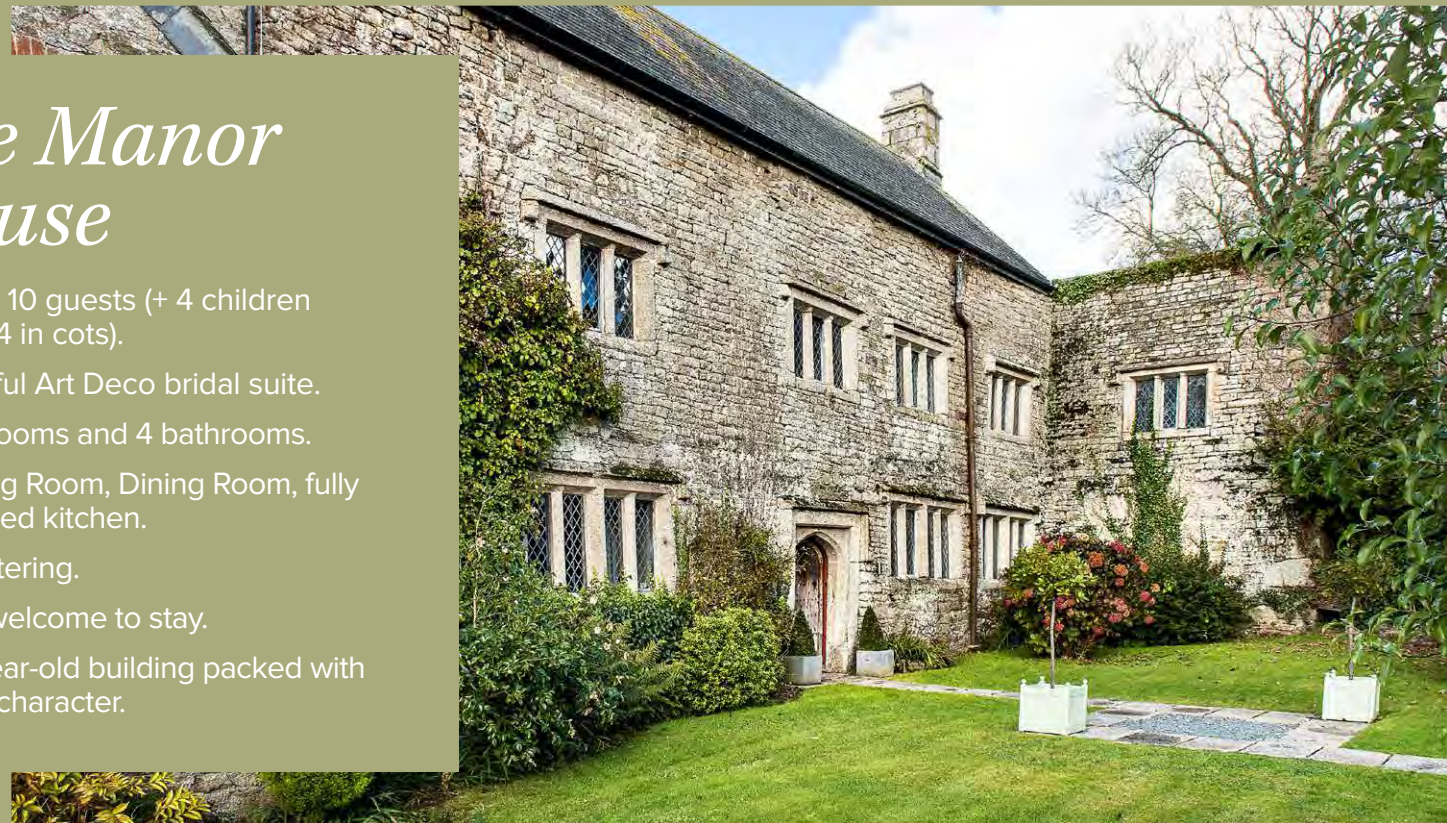
